# Can You Answer the Door?




#### You will need:

Cards (one set of 6 double sided cards for each player)
Dice
Base board for each player
Counters or beads

### To play: (a game for 2 players)

- •The players each have a base board which they use to put one question card behind each door by slotting it in the slit.
- •The first player throws the dice and goes to the door marked with that number.
- •The card contains a story problem on each side which needs a numerical answer. The player chooses one question to answer.
- •The player can use counters to help work out the answer, then the other player checks with the answer list to see if they are right.
- •If they get the correct answer the player keeps the number of counters from the answer and puts the story card to one side.
- •If they get a wrong answer they can turn the card over and try the question on the other side. If still wrong they replace the card and try again next time they throw that door number.
- •If a player throws a number which has already been answered correctly, they can throw again.
- •The game continues with the next player having a turn to throw the dice.
- •The winner is the player with the most counters at the end when they have answered all 6 questions on their baseboard.
- \* When played again make sure players choose a different colour set of question cards than before.
