pick-a-strip

You will need: The question sheets on Slides 2 and 4 printed and cut into strips and placed in a box in the centre of the table.

Object of the game: To grasp the inverse relationship between addition and subtraction. Players pick a strip of paper from a box and decide the answer, They then have to decide if their answer is 'the same', 'more' or 'less' than the number given at the start of the question.

Instructions: The game is for 2 - 4 players. The question strips on Slides 2 and 4 are cut into separate sums and placed in a box in the centre of the table. Players take turns to 'pick-a-strip' from the box, read the question and decide if their answer is 'more', 'less' or 'the same' as the original number in the question.

If the player gives a correct answer, the player keeps the strip; if the player gives an incorrect answer then s/he must return the strip to the box. The winner is the player with the most strips at the end of the game.

Check the answer: Answers can be checked by printing Slides 3 and 5.
