Did she do it?

Aim

- To give children practice in choosing the correct form of the verb for the past tense, depending on if they 'did' do the action or 'did not'.
- You will need:
 Base board, dice, counters, 2-way picture cards


To play (for 2-3 players)

- The cards are shared equally between the players.
- The first player throws the dice and moves their counter the number of squares shown on the dice.
- They look at the picture on which they have landed in the square and see if they have a card with a matching picture for the verb.
- If they have, they then match which form of the verb to put down, either for the 'did' do it, or for the 'did not' do it in the past tense. They then decide in which pile on the board to put their card, the 'did' or 'did not' pile.

e.g 'smile' (He did not smile) goes in the 'no' pile

'smiled' (He smiled) goes in the 'yes' pile.

- They communicate the whole sentence 'Yes, he smiled' or 'No, he did not smile'.
- If they do not have a card which matches, the next player has a turn to throw the dice.
- The winner is the first player to correctly place all their cards on the board.
