

Describing the 'What' (Adjectives) activity

- Aim: Encouraging children to think about which words add more information to the noun.
- The children are given sentences with a space for the chosen adjectives and a selection of words to choose from, some are adjectives, some nouns, so they first have to identify which are adjectives.
- Then they have to decide which adjectives best describe the picture
- e.g. We saw a flower (tall, pretty, yellow)
- e.g. I like a dog (happy, small, friendly)
- Children are asked to choose 3 words which give the best information about the object in the picture.
