Week 5 Board Game 11 Bingo

<u>Aim:</u> To reinforce verbs in present (third person singular) and past (regular '-ed') tense.

How to play 'Bingo':

One person is the 'caller' and reads the card in English / BSL depending on the players.

If the children identify the word on their card they raise their hand. The 'caller' checks the answer, and if correct, the child is given the card to place on top of the matching word.

The winner is the first to complete their card.
