Week 9 Game 20 - '-able', '-al', '-y' suffixes

Aim:


To give children practice in matching the correct suffix with a verb or a noun to form an adjective.

To play:

A game for 2 players

(You will need the board, a dice, 2counters, a recording sheet for each child and a pencil)

- How to play:
- 1. Put the counters on 'start' and the first player throws the dice.
- 2. The first player moves the counter the correct number of jumps as on dice.
- 3. If they land on a stem word, they mark off the stem word on their list and write the stem word in the space on their recording sheet. Then they add one of the suffixes which are written in the middle of the board.
- 4. If they land on a corner square they might miss a turn or get an extra turn.
- 5. The next player has a turn to throw the dice and move the counter. They also mark off and write down the stem word and then add their choice of suffix.
- 6. If they land on a word already marked off on the bottom of the list, they have another turn.
- 7. When each player has written down 6 different words with their choice of suffix, they mark each others list of words to see if they are all correct. (There is a list of correct words on the reverse of the board which can be used for checking at the end).
- 8. The winner is the player who has the most words correct.
