Prepositions

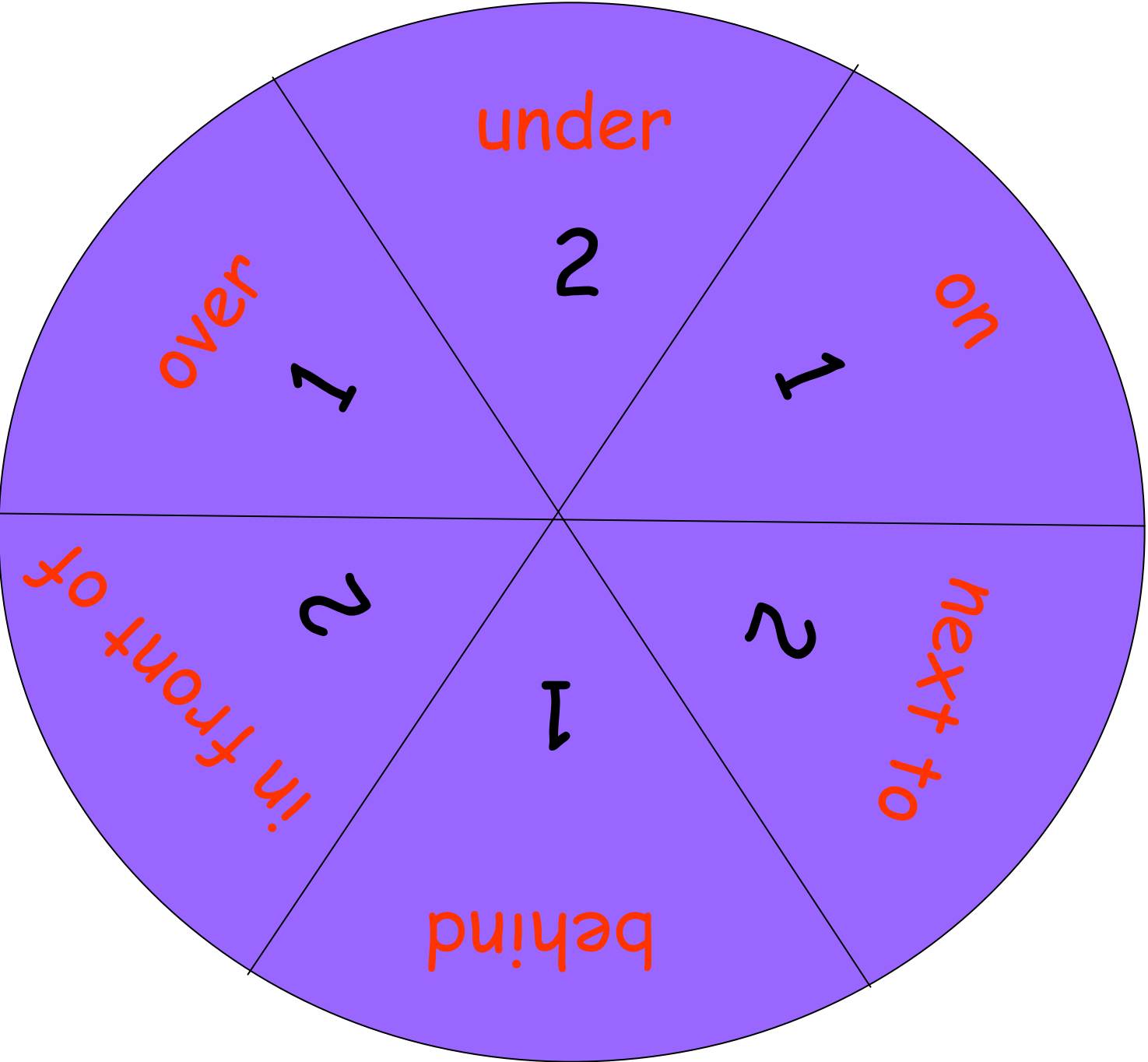
Aim:

To reinforce 'position' words using objects

To Play:

You will need the spinning board , selection of 3D objects from your room (e.g. pencil pot, book, water bottle, paper clip, ruler)
recording sheet, pencil

- The first player spins the arrow and reads the preposition which lands by the arrow.
- The player then has to use 3D objects to demonstrate the position to their partner, e.g. show the 'paper clip' **on** the 'book'.
- If correct, they receive the number of points marked on the wheel. The child enters the preposition on their recording sheet and the number of points received for being correct.
- Then the second child has a turn and spins the arrow.
- When each child has had 6 words, the winner is the child who totals the most points. Some of the words may be repeated if the spinner lands on the same word more than once.

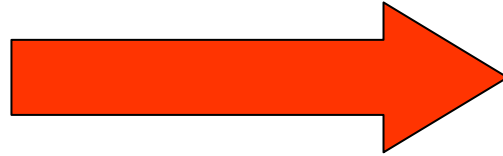
