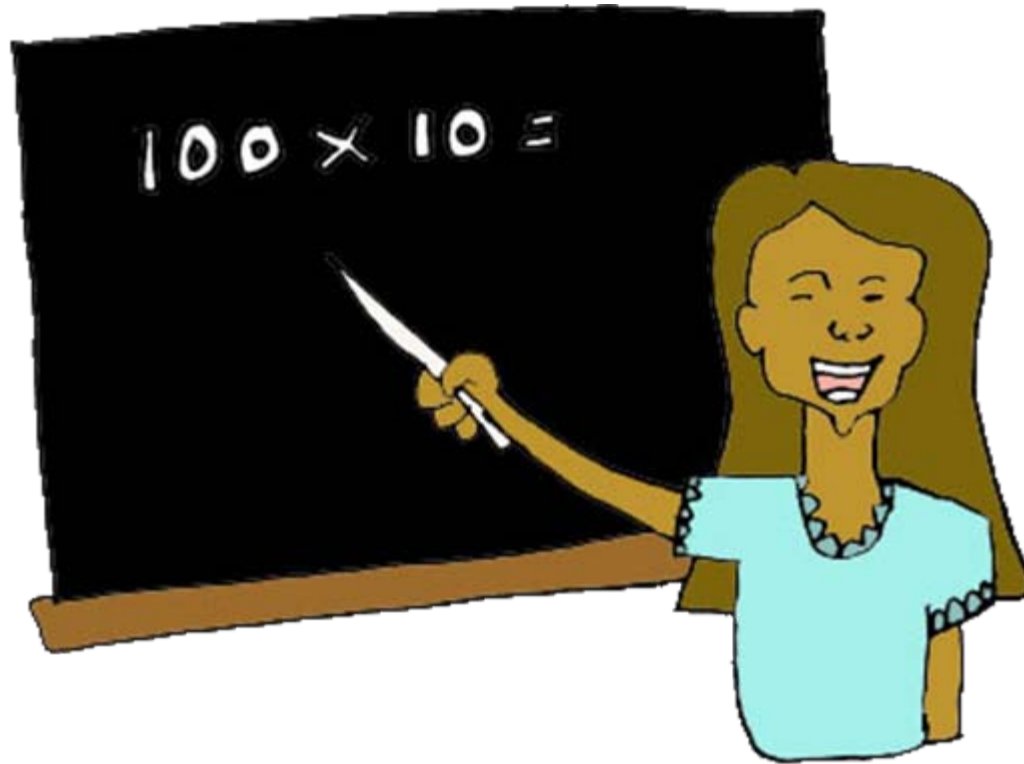

"I farm,

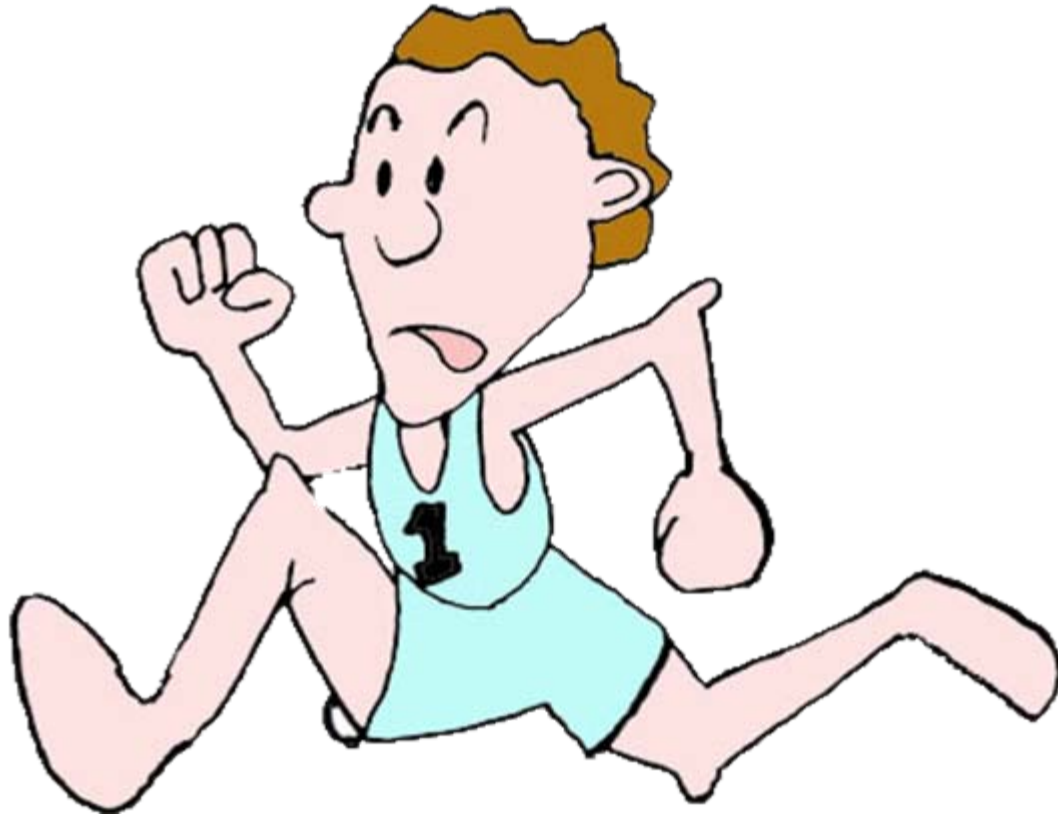
I am a farmer."
