Did I buy it?

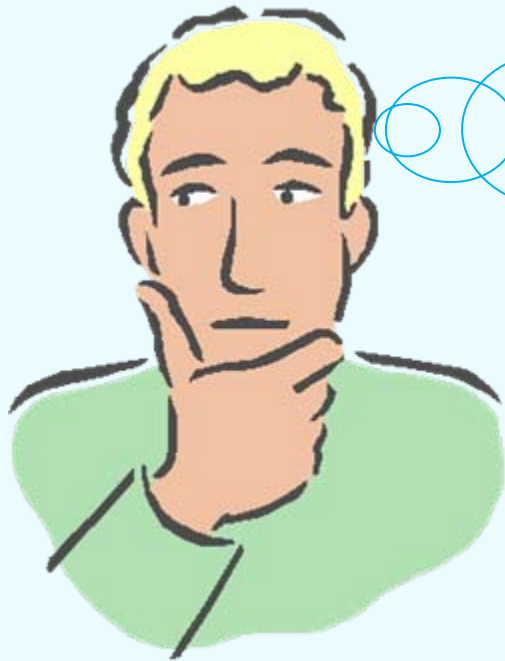


The bear is not washable. It will get very dirty when she plays with it.

Did I buy it?

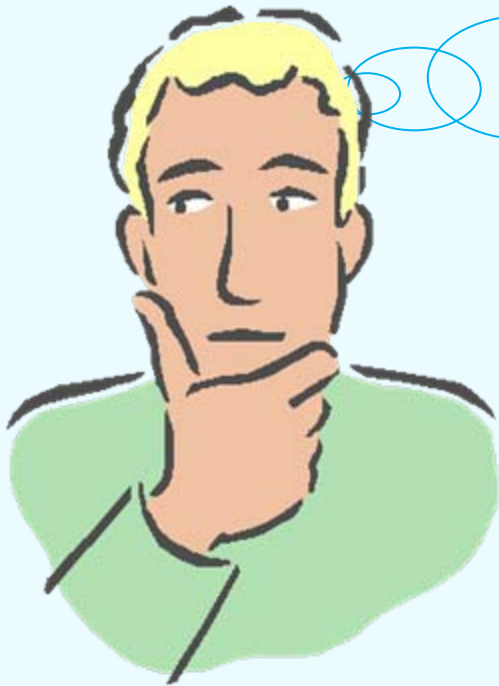
It is magical but she has lots of dresses in

No, I did not buy it.

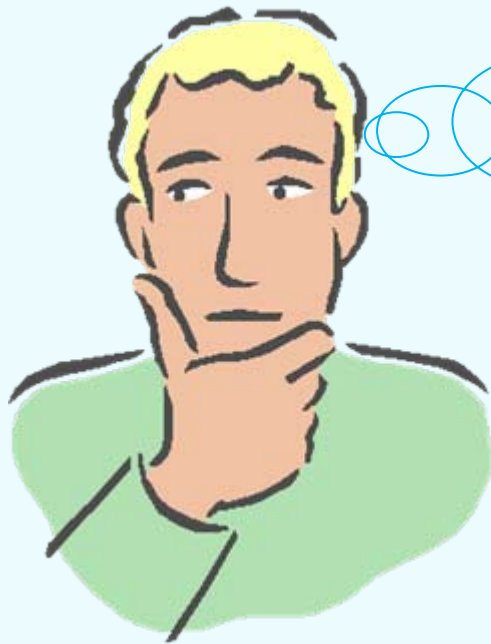
I looked at a pink fluffy rabbit.
