
He looked in the bin but it was not there. So he walked on.....




He looked between the washing machine and the bucket but it was not there. So he walked on.....




He looked behind the curtains but it was not there. So he walked on.....






He looked in front of the television but it was not there. So he walked on.....




He looked over the bath but it was not in there. So he walked on......




He looked in the shower but it was not there. So he walked on.....







He looked on the chair. He found the cat but the bone was not there. So he walked on.



He looked out of the window. The sun was shining. He decided to go for a walk.....




He went out to the field. Next to the tree he saw his friend Basil. He ran up to Basil.






"I have looked:
